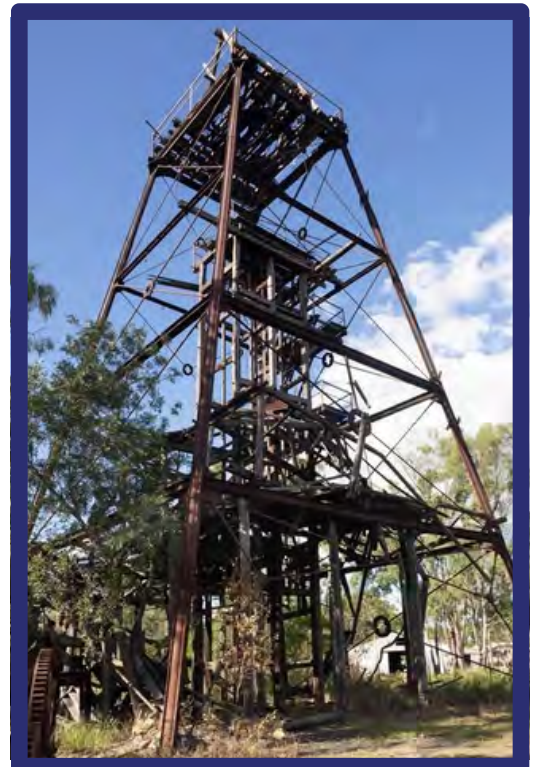
BCCM No1 MINE
